- 1. CAM Challenge specific rules are online: scca.com/pages/cam-challenge
- 2. You are required to run the CAM Challenge decal on your competition vehicle. Decals will be available at tech.
- 3. Session 1 will not have an Impound. Times from Session 1 will be posted as soon as they are audited and will be available for review during the worker/driver change. If there are any questions with posted times, please see one the Assistant Operation Stewards with your question. When Session 2 starts, the Session 1 runs will be deemed approved by competitors and marked FINAL (unless an issue has already been brought to our attention).
- 4. Trophies will be awarded on Saturday after the last runs. Competitors must be present to accept their trophy or have a designee accept it for them. Trophies will NOT be mailed.
- 5. Sound requirements strictly enforced- See Solo Rules appendix I.
- 6. Class changes are not allowed after 7pm Friday.
- 7. Cars will be weighed during tech inspection. Cars may be weighed again at any time at the discretion of the Event Officials without notice or cause.
