To gather a group of experienced, successful TRSS Coaches/Instructors in a given geographic area to help and guide new organizers to a successful Tire Rack Street Survival School.




## SCCA TRSS Mentor Program

#### Team Staffing

- Organizer/Event Chairman
  - Overall Responsibility for the Event
  - Spokesperson for the Group
- Registrar
  - Monitors Registration Process
  - Resolves Issues with Registration Process
  - Keeps Organizer Informed



## Organizing a School

- Team Staffing
  - Safety Steward
    - Approves Exercise Layout
    - Monitors Driving Exercises
  - Classroom Instructor
    - Teaching/Lecture Experience Preferred
    - 1st School Mentor Presents, Instructor Shadows



## Organizing a School

- Driving Coaches
  - Training Required
  - 2:1 Student to Coach Ratio Good -Lower is Better!
- Course Workers/Event Staff
  - Assist with Setup/Teardown
  - Shag Cones During Exercises
  - Reconfigure Exercises
  - Runners
