This event will be a low risk “racing experience” event that provides an instructional environment to experience and learn about wheel-to-wheel racing in an easy to access format under SCCA Club Racing Experience rules.

DRIVER ELIGIBILITY

- Must have a SCCA regular membership or SCCA weekend membership (available at the track.)
- Must certify that you have no known medical conditions that would cause yourself or other undue risk.
- Drivers must provide their SCCA Track Participation Log to record participation in the event. If you do not yet have an SCCA Track Participation Log, you will receive one at the event.

VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

- Vehicles shall be production-based vehicles with a performance level equal or less than normal in Club Racing classes Improved Touring R, E Production, SCCA GT-3 or Touring 3.
- Spec Racer Fords may also be included.
- Vehicles that may be of a performance higher than those listed above will need to be approved by the Chief Steward prior to the event. SCCA Vehicle Logbooks are not required. All vehicles must meet the safety and equipment requirements of GCR 9.3. All vehicles must meet the safety and equipment requirements of GCR 9.4. “Roll cages for GT and Production based cars” or Appendix I, “2007 Cage Rules”.
- The Chief Steward may waive deviations of compliance requirements for a car for an event.

DRIVER CONDUCT



SCCA CLUB RACING

- On track behavior will be in the spirit of GCR section 6. Any participant found to be overaggressive or dangerous may be black flagged and counseled by the Chief Instructor or his designee or excluded from the event.
- At a minimum any participant being found at fault in an accident will be put on probation for a recommended 13 months. Any participant being found at fault in an accident while on probation will be excluded from further participation in these events for 13 months.
