Award Information:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Cash awards are presented to 1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> place drivers in all eligible classes at the 2017 SCCA National Championship Runoffs.</li><li>In addition, Mazda will provide a \$2,000 award to any Mazda driver that earns a Super Sweep award.</li><li>The Mazda competitor must finish ahead of 4 other starters in the class to receive a 100% payout; awards are reduced by 15% for finishing ahead of three other competitors, 25% if ahead of two other competitors, 50% if ahead of one other competitor.</li><li>Mazda will use a one-way driving distance to Indianapolis Motor Speedway based on the competitor zip code on file with Mazda to award tow fund money to the top three finishers in the Majors Conference Points Championship standings.</li><li>All contingency award claim forms (from <a href="http://www.MazdaMotorsports.com">www.MazdaMotorsports.com</a>) must be accompanied by a copy of the official race results and be postmarked no later than 45 days after the event.</li><li>See "Payout Schedule" below for award amounts.</li></ul>
