- 1. CAM Challenge specific rules are online: http://www.scca.com/pages/cam-challenge
- 2. Event decals required are two CAM Challenge decals, one on each side of the vehicle & an SCCA decal o the front of the car, other required sponsor decals will be provided at tech.
- 3. The course will be open for walking between Session 1 and Session 2 for approximately 30 minutes (if time allows).
- 4. Session 1 will not have impound. Times from Session 1 will be posted as soon as they are audited and will be available for review during the course walk. If there are any questions with posted times, please see one the Administrators with your question. When Session 2 starts, the Session 1 runs will be deemed approved by competitors and marked FINAL (unless an issue has already been brought to our attention).
- 5. Trophies will be awarded on Saturday after the last runs. Competitors must be present to accept their trophy or have a designee accept it for them. Trophies will NOT be mailed.
- 6. Class changes are not allowed after 7pm Friday.

Site Regulations/Restrictions for Grissom Aeroplex:
