

Roads Scholar National Course Rally on Saturday will be a scenic 180 mile rally through the marvelous country roads <u>east</u> of Madison on roads that you've never seen before. Designed for experienced rallyists who are familiar with the RRR's, it will have a fixed main road rule (Onto, Protection, T-rule, SAP) and both Numbered and Lettered instructions. It will not have Aristotle traps or 'Absence of the sign' traps. The course uses only paved roads. Speeds are moderate and free zones are used extensively. You'll enjoy seeing the all new rally territory and a new headquarters hotel.

Roads Scholar Divisional Course Rally on Sunday will be a 4 hour 110 mile rally that will use the same General Instructions as the National, but the rally will be easier. Having warmed up on Saturday, you'll get to apply the same GI's to a shorter event and finish early Sunday afternoon. Like the National, the Divisional will use only paved roads.
