## Southeast RunOffs Alternate Path 2019 Rules

2/8/2019-- by Jim Creighton SEDiv Race Administrator

1. All Runoffs qualifying races will be SARRC events. An event is described as a race weekend.
  2. All qualifying SARRC events will be held between March 1st and September 2nd.
  3. A driver must enter a minimum of four SARRC events to be eligible for the SEDiv Alternate path.
  4. An event weekend may have one or two SARRC point races.
  5. Alternate path consideration is restricted to RunOffs eligible classes.
  6. All points will be as per the regular season SARRC points. (see SARRC Rules [www.sedivrracing.com](http://www.sedivrracing.com) )
  7. RunOffs invitations will be extended to the top 3 drivers in the SARRC regular season standings in each class who are not otherwise qualified for a RunOffs Invitation(top 5 in SM & SRF) and who have completed in at least 4 SARRC event weekends. (SIC Points will not count-too close to Runoffs date)
- \*. As per GCR, Southeast & Northeast Division drivers in the top 50% of points are eligible space permitting.**
