- 1. Program specific supplemental regulations are posted at the Lincoln Driver's Center.
- 2. The Tire Rack® is the title sponsor for all 2019 SCCA® National Solo® events. Participants in these events are required to run the title sponsor decal, which is a windshield decal that is to be used at the top of the windshield. Vehicles without windshields or with plastic windshields may place the decal on the front of the car in a highly visible location approved by the Chief of Compliance. Decals other than the official Tire Rack® decal, except those required by National Tour Staff, are prohibited on the windshield.
- 3. Additional event decals required are one SCCA® w/wheel (on the front) and 2 National Tour decals (one on each side).
- 4. Competitors at the start line with the wrong number on their car, 2 sets of numbers, or the incorrect class showing will receive a warning for the first offense, a cone penalty for the second offense and may receive a DSQ for three or more offenses at the same event.
- 5. Competitors at the scanner with more than one (1) barcode showing on the helmet will receive a warning for the first offense, a cone penalty for the second offense and may receive a DSQ for three or more offenses at the same event. A driver at the scanner or the start line without the appropriate helmet decal (Solo 2019) will be directed away from the start and lose the run.
- 6. Trophy presentation will be held on Sunday after the last runs. Competitors must be present to accept their trophy or have a designee accept it for them. Trophies will NOT be mailed.
- 7. Changing tire brands for any reason will affect contingency eligibility.
- 8. Preliminary Results posted in the Lincoln drivers center after completion of all runs for the heat. Results will be final 30 minutes after preliminary results are posted.
- 9. Worker check in at the Lincoln Drivers Center starting 3rd runs of the previous heat, your work assignment may have changed within your heat due to cancellations or class changes.
- 10. It is your responsibility to know when your car should be in grid, and when you should report for your work assignment.
- 11. Impound is in grid it's your responsibility to know if your vehicle is supposed to be weighed.
- 12. Check final results to make sure the manufacturer is correct for your car and tire brand.
- 13. Sound requirements are strictly enforced.
- 14. All class changes must be approved by the Chief Steward or their designee.
- 15. Event is a CAM Points Event. CAM Rules can be found on the CAM page on the SCCA web site.
- 16. CAM, Open and Bonus Challenges will follow the last heat on Saturday.

FM radio frequency will be posted or go to the event page on SCCA.com to stream audio and sololive.scca.com (216.58.239.33) for live results and audio streaming.

SITE RESTRICTIONS:

- No alcohol permitted on site
- Camping is not permitted on site, but is allowed in the campground
- Everyone must be off site by 7pm
