Pre-Event Responsibilities

- Work with tech to inspect Karts
- Walk course looking for possible obstacles that need to be specially marked for the Junior karters
- Decide where the Junior kart grid will be and work with the Chief of Grid and the Chief of Course to determine the best method to get the Junior karters back to their grid safely
- Determine if there are any two driver karts and if you can, work with the parents/drivers and the Chief of Timing ahead of time to determine the best way/order to run the Junior karts to minimize down time between runs.
- Assist Admin Manager in assigning age appropriate work assignments
- Verify the experience level of the Junior drivers. If any are inexperienced, conduct a vehicle orientation session and lead at least 2 course walks with instruction

Event Day Responsibilities

- Pick up a radio from the SCCA trailer 20 minutes prior to Junior kart competition for ease of communication in the Junior Kart grid
- Conduct a Junior Driver meeting & safety talk
- Verify that all Junior drivers are wearing appropriate gear
- Oversee any kart adjustments made in the grid area
- Work with the Chief of Timing and the Chief of Grid or their designee to manage any re-runs
- Follow JDP guidelines during event as defined in the Junior Kart Program Guidelines and the Solo Rule Book
- Be available during competition in case a kart needs to be re-teched

Post Event Responsibilities

• Turn in radio
