- 1. Match Tour specific rules are online: <u>https://www.scca.com/pages/match-tour</u>. For Day one competition, the Champ Tour Generic Supps will be applied. For both days of competition, the CAM rules handout will be applied. The Tire Rack<sup>®</sup> is the title sponsor for all 2019 SCCA<sup>®</sup> National Solo<sup>®</sup> events. Participants in these events are required to run the title sponsor decal, which is a windshield decal that is to be used at the top of the windshield. Vehicles without windshields may place the decal on the front of the car in a highly visible location approved by the Operations Manager. Decals other than the official Tire Rack<sup>®</sup> decal, except those required by National Tour Staff, are prohibited on the windshield.
- 2. Additional event decals required are one SCCA<sup>®</sup> w/wheel (on the front) and 2 National Tour decals (one on each side). No competing sanctioning body decals may be visible.
- 3. The course will be open for walking between Session 1 and Session 2 for approximately 30 minutes.
- 4. Session 1 will not have an impound. Times from Session 1 will be posted as soon as they are audited and will be available for review during the course walk. If there are any questions with posted times, please see one the Assistant Operation Stewards with your question. When Session 2 starts, the Session 1 runs will be deemed approved by competitors and marked FINAL (unless an issue has already been brought to our attention).
- 6. Trophies will be awarded on Saturday night. Competitors must be present to accept their trophy or have a designee accept it for them. Trophies will NOT be mailed.
- 7. Contingency winners should go to <u>www.scca.com/forms/contingency-input-form</u> and complete the required information in order to receive contingencies. Changing tire brands for any reason will affect contingency eligibility.
- 8. Check final results to make sure the manufacture is correct for your car and tire brand.
- 9. Sound requirements strictly enforced- See Solo Rules appendix I.
