



A bridge port is a street port with another port added in the runner with a "bridge" of material between the added port and the modified original port. The purpose of the bridge is to support the side and corner seals preventing them from dropping into the intake path. The O-ring water jacket seal groove can be removed. The section of the groove that has the "O" ring that seals the water jacket, can be removed to open the port further, but the line of material on the water jacket side needs to be left to seal against the side of the rotor housing.
