



A peripheral port is like a rotor housing exhaust port except for placement and mixture goes in, not out. A peripheral port comes straight in the side of the rotor housing into the combustion chamber. These require some form modification to the water jacket in the rotor housing to allow for a port going through. The part shown has been "recast" around the port to block the water jacket and allow for an intake port. Inserts are also commonly used. See attached image.
