## Southeast Divisional Path Participation + Performance

- Participate in a minimum of 4 SARRC event weekends within the same car class for each invitation to the Runoffs. Participate" is defined as turning a wheel on track in an official session (practice, qualifying, warm-up, race) and appearing in the Official Race Results.
  - A. Optional: Replace/Substitute (1) one SARRC event by participating in (1) one U.S. Majors Tour event weekend.
  - B. If a Region holds a "dual" event; a Majors with a Regional-sanctioned run group and a driver participates in both, in the same Runoffs eligible class, Majors credit will automatically be earned toward qualification. Drivers must make a separate request to the SARRC Administrator to also receive SARRC points for these events. A driver competing at a "dual" event receives credit for one participation weekend. Three additional SARRC weekends are required.
  - C. SARRC events must occur prior to September 12, 2021 to count.
  - D. This path excludes any Enduros. You must participate in the SARRC race(s).
- 2. Performance criteria is finishing in the TOP 3 of your car class (Top 5 for SM/SRF3) in the SARRC Divisional Point Standings.
