Award Information:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cash awards are presented to the 1st – 5th place drivers in the final point's standings for each 2022 SCCA Road Racing Divisional Championship. For full payout: in divisions with 8 or fewer races, racer must compete in 5 races; in divisions with 9-13 races, racer must compete in 6 races; in divisions with 14-19 races, racer must compete in 7 races; in divisions with 20+ races, racer must compete in 8 races. Must finish ahead of minimum number of racers. Race count does not include the Runoffs. First contingency awards request per year must include a compliant photo of self in your driver's suit (without helmet) showing the 5" Mazda patch and a photo of your Mazda race vehicle. To receive full payout, award claim forms must be accompanied by a copy of the official race results and be postmarked within 45 days of the event. See "Payout Schedule" below for award amounts.
