Award Information:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>The Trans Am Series Pro Am Challenge is designed for the SCCA road racers with pro level aspirations.</li><li>The Pro Am Challenge allows SCCA road racers to compete in Trans Am using their same SCCA road racing trim, which simplifies the back and forth transition between the SCCA Road Racing program and Trans Am.</li><li>Racers in GT1, GT2 and T1 are eligible as cars correlate to Trans Am classes with only minor weight and restrictor changes.</li><li>Pro Am Challenge racers wanting to compete for the Pro Am Challenge Championship can choose from either the National or Western Trans Am Championships, thus creating their own custom six-race championship.</li><li>\$4,000 credit towards Trans Am Series Fees to top finisher in each class without prior Trans Am experience.</li><li>\$2,500 credit towards Trans Am Series Fees to second highest finisher in each class without prior Trans Am experience.</li><li>\$1,500 credit towards Trans Am Series Fees to third highest finisher in each class without prior Trans Am experience.</li><li>The credit can be applied towards series fees, including competition license, vehicle registration, crew credentials, event entry fees and/or test day fees. Credit is not applicable towards consumables like tire or fuel costs.</li></ul>
