

2023 Tire Rack® SCCA® Solo® National Tour Series Points

SCCA Tire Rack Solo National Tour Series points create an opportunity for enthusiasts to compete for a year end class championship as part of the National Tour program. The series includes all 2023 SCCA Tire Rack Solo National Tour events and the Tire Rack SCCA Solo Nationals Championship.

Class Championships and Series Points Guidelines

- A. Series points for the National Tour Class Championships will be accumulated by National Tour Series class finishing positioning in the best three (3) events entered. To be eligible for year-end awards, you must compete in the same class at three (3) Tours and Nationals. Series points will only be awarded to entrants with an annual membership at the time the event points are earned.
- B. Awarding of Points
 - 1. An event is counted for the class championship when a driver has started at least one (1) run in class competition at an event. Points are awarded on a per-class, per-event basis.
 - 2. In case of a point finishing position tie, the tiebreaker will be their relative finishing position in the Solo Nationals Championship.
 - 3. If a competitor is disqualified at the Tire Rack SCCA Solo National Championship, all or a portion of the Series points may be revoked, and their finishing position may be vacated.
 - 4. End of the year class awards will be presented based on the following schedule of the number of Series participants. To be considered a Series participant, a driver must compete in three (3) National Tour Series events and the Tire Rack SCCA Solo National Championship in the same class.

C. Class Points

1. Points will be performance-based utilizing the following formula for each event:

$$100 - (900 \times ((\text{Entrant's Time} - \text{Class-Winning Time}) / (\text{Class-Winning Time})))$$

2. Competitors who complete at least one timed run per event will receive a minimum of 20 points for that event.

3. Class Points Example:
