Revised Schedule

With the early entry deadline having passed last night, the Race Director has revised the qualifying and race day schedule, which can be found at https://www.scca.com/runoffs. There are three edits based on car counts – the two largest combined-class qualifying groups (T2/T3 and FP/GTL) will each have one day where they are split; and due to low car count, Formula Atlantic has been combined with Formula Continental for their race on Saturday. This race will have a split start.
