It's a holiday weekend – Happy Friday! Tee-minus 3 weeks until we start loading in at VIR.

Here is the important news for this week:

Hagerty:

Did you know? Hagerty is back for another year as the official sponsor of Runoffs Race Days! Revised Schedule:

With the early entry deadline having passed last night, the Race Director has revised the qualifying and race day schedule, which can be found at <https://www.scca.com/runoffs>. There are three edits based on car counts – the two largest combined-class qualifying groups (T2/T3 and FP/GTL) will each have one day where they are split; and due to low car count, Formula Atlantic has been combined with Formula Continental for their race on Saturday. This race will have a split start.

Race Live Broadcast On-Board Camera Opportunity:

In our continuing effort to improve coverage of the SCCA Runoffs, Apex Broadcast is adding live on-board cameras to the 2023 production. These camera systems have been used extensively in Apex's coverage of professional racing series. Unlike consumer-grade solutions, these on-board cameras provide ultra-low latency, broadcast-quality images appropriate for use in live TV production. We're very excited to bring this technology to the Runoffs.
