Schedule Adjustment – FV & T3 Races Affected!

GT-1 will have qualifying sessions both Wednesday and Thursday, but their race time, scheduled for Saturday at 3 p.m., is canceled and the FV and Touring 3 races have been moved up one hour, respectively.
